To All Twins Parents/Guardians:

The past five seasons have established the Glacier Twins as one of the premier Class A American Legion Baseball organizations in the State of Montana.

- ❖ In 2014, the Twins won the Montana State Championship and finished in 3rd place at the Northwest Regionals in Anchorage, Alaska
- ❖ In 2015, the Twins season resulted in a 17-3 record in conference play and #1 seed in the post-season District Tournament
- ❖ In 2016, the Twins finished #1 in District Conference play but runner-up to the Bitterroot Red Sox in both District and State Tournament play
- ❖ In 2017, the Twins went 22-2 in conference play
- ❖ In 2018, the Twins had their greatest season yet, winning Conference, District and State Tourneys before steam-rolling through the Northwest Regional Tournament in Lewiston, Idaho!

The 2019 baseball season will be upon us before we know it! The Board and Coaches have been busy putting together plans for the upcoming season. We plan to again field both an A and B team. **Scott Murray** will remain as our **Head Coach** with **Kevin Slaybaugh** serving as **General Manager** for the upcoming season.

Our sign-ups begin now, so if you know someone who would like to play for the Glacier Twins, please have them contact a Coach or Board Member for a registration form.

All players participating in Twins Baseball will need to have a physical prior to participation. A copy of his high school sports physical will be accepted. Indoor practice will begin in January. All players participating in off-season training are covered by Twins insurance. Players must have a passport or passport card since we will have games scheduled in Canada.

Does playing Twins Baseball cost money? Yes, there is a commitment of both time and money on the part of the player and parent/guardian. A non-refundable payment of \$300 (Player Registration Fee) is due by March 1st. Payment plans for this Registration Fee can be set up by paying \$100 each in December, January and February. Players are expected to earn an additional \$1,200 in credits or cash by June 1, 2019. Refer to page entitled **Fundraising Goals for examples of how easily this can be accomplished.**

All these fees/fundraisers help in paying for the costs associated with playing American Legion Baseball and being able to travel to games and tournaments that require overnight stays. Parents and family members are also responsible for helping and/or participating by selling tickets at the gate, announcing, operating the scoreboard, field prep at double-headers, obtaining new fence sign advertisers and major sponsors, etc. Parents are expected to volunteer for a minimum of five (5) work assignments through SignUpGenius. FYI - Assisting at a garland hang day counts as one work assignment.

We would like to encourage participation by ALL PARENTS. If you have questions with regard to cost, participation requirements, parental commitment or schedule, please feel free to contact any one of the Twins Board Members. Assistance Scholarships are available to those players who may find the fee structure a challenge. Please contact your coach or any Board member if you have any questions about these scholarships.
