### Twins Parents/Guardians:

The past six seasons have established the Glacier Twins as one of the premier Class A American Legion Baseball organizations in the State of Montana.

- ❖ 2014 - Won the Montana State Championship and finished 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Northwest Regionals in Anchorage, AK
- ❖ 2015 - 17-3 record in Conference play and #1 seed in the post-season District Tournament
- ❖ 2016 - Finished #1 in District Conference 2<sup>nd</sup> in both District and State Tournament play
- ❖ 2017 - Went 22-2 in Conference play
- ❖ 2018 - Won Conference, District and State Tourneys before steam-rolling through the Northwest Regional Tournament in Lewiston, Idaho!
- ❖ 2019 - Finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in Conference and runner-up to Mariners in Conference Tourney

The 2020 baseball season will be upon us before we know it! The Board and Coaches have been busy putting together plans for the upcoming season. **Kevin Slaybaugh** will take over as **Head Coach**. **Casey Corbett** will continue to manage the B Team. Other changes include **Lindsey Andrachick** serving as **General Manager** and **Bob Rupp** stepping in as **Board of Directors President**.

**All players participating in Twins Baseball will need to have a physical prior to participation.** A high school sports physical will be accepted. Indoor practice will begin in January. All players participating in off-season training are covered by Twins insurance. Players must have a passport or passport card since we will have games scheduled in Canada.

**A non-refundable payment of \$300 (Player Registration Fee) is due by our General Meeting on March 9. Payment plans for this Registration Fee can be set up by paying \$100 each in January, February and March. Players are expected to earn an additional \$1,300 in credits or cash by June 1. Refer to page entitled Fundraising Goals for examples of how easily this can be accomplished.** Assistance Scholarships are available to those players who may find the fee structure a challenge. Please contact your coach or any Board member if you have any questions about these scholarships.

**With an annual budget of close to \$135,000, there is a required commitment of both time and money on the part of everyone involved with the Glacier Twins.** Player fees and fundraisers help to pay for the costs associated with playing baseball, maintaining our field and being able to travel to games and tournaments that require overnight stays. Parents and family members are responsible for helping and/or participating at home games by selling tickets at the gate, announcing, operating the scoreboard, and field prep at double-headers. Fundraising obligations include obtaining new fence sign advertisers and major sponsors (which go toward player credits), as well as assisting at our annual concert and any other scheduled events. We use SignUpGenius to allow parents to plan their volunteering. Links will be made via email as schedules are completed.
